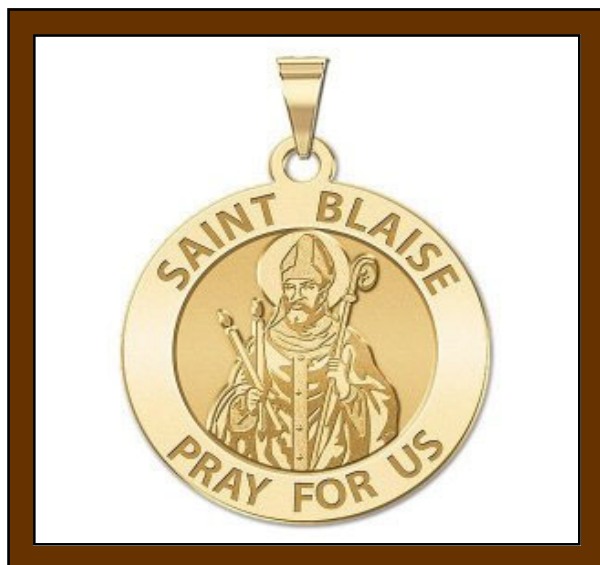

couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year  
prior to the wedding date.

A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married,  
married in the Church.

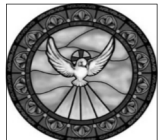


### CLASSICAL CONCERT ST. JOHN VIANNEY CHAPEL TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14
