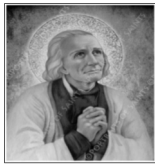


WORLD DAY OF THE SICK ST. COLUMBAN'S CHURCH SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 11

Diamond Jubilee of Priestly Ordination.

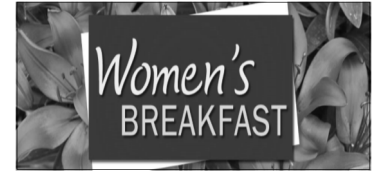
