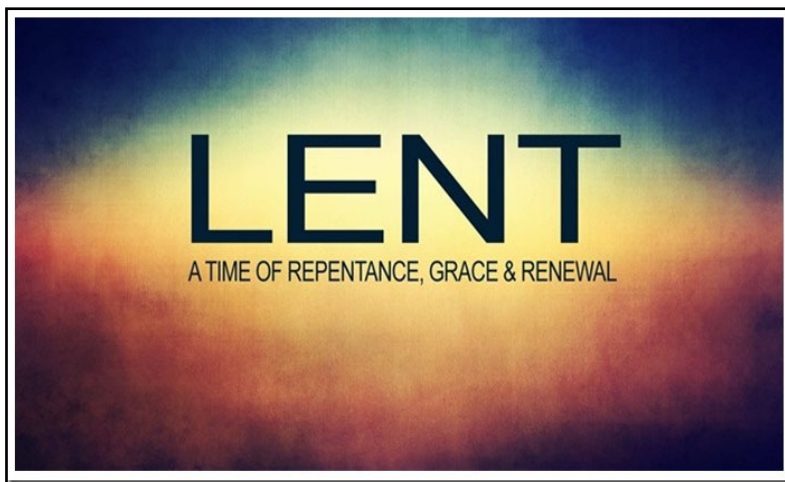

Eucharistic Adoration

The fourth day of every month unless the fourth day falls on Sunday or a national holiday.

Sacrament of the Sick

In the event of a serious illness or a medical emergency, Monsignor Baird should be contacted immediately so that the Sacraments of the Church may be celebrated.

Funerals

At the death of a loved one, please notify Monsignor Baird so that a date and time for the Funeral Liturgy may be arranged.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the parish office six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

Baptisms

Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for the first Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents. A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.

Come to the Chapel on **Friday evenings during Lent** for the traditional devotion of the **STATIONS OF THE CROSS** at **7:30 p.m.**



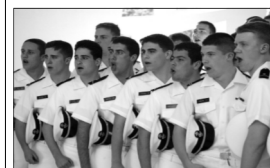
**ANNUAL 50/50 RAFFLE

"Catholicism: The Pivotal Players" will begin at **7:30 p.m.** Discussion will follow and center around the life of *Michelangelo: The Artist*.



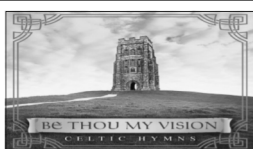
