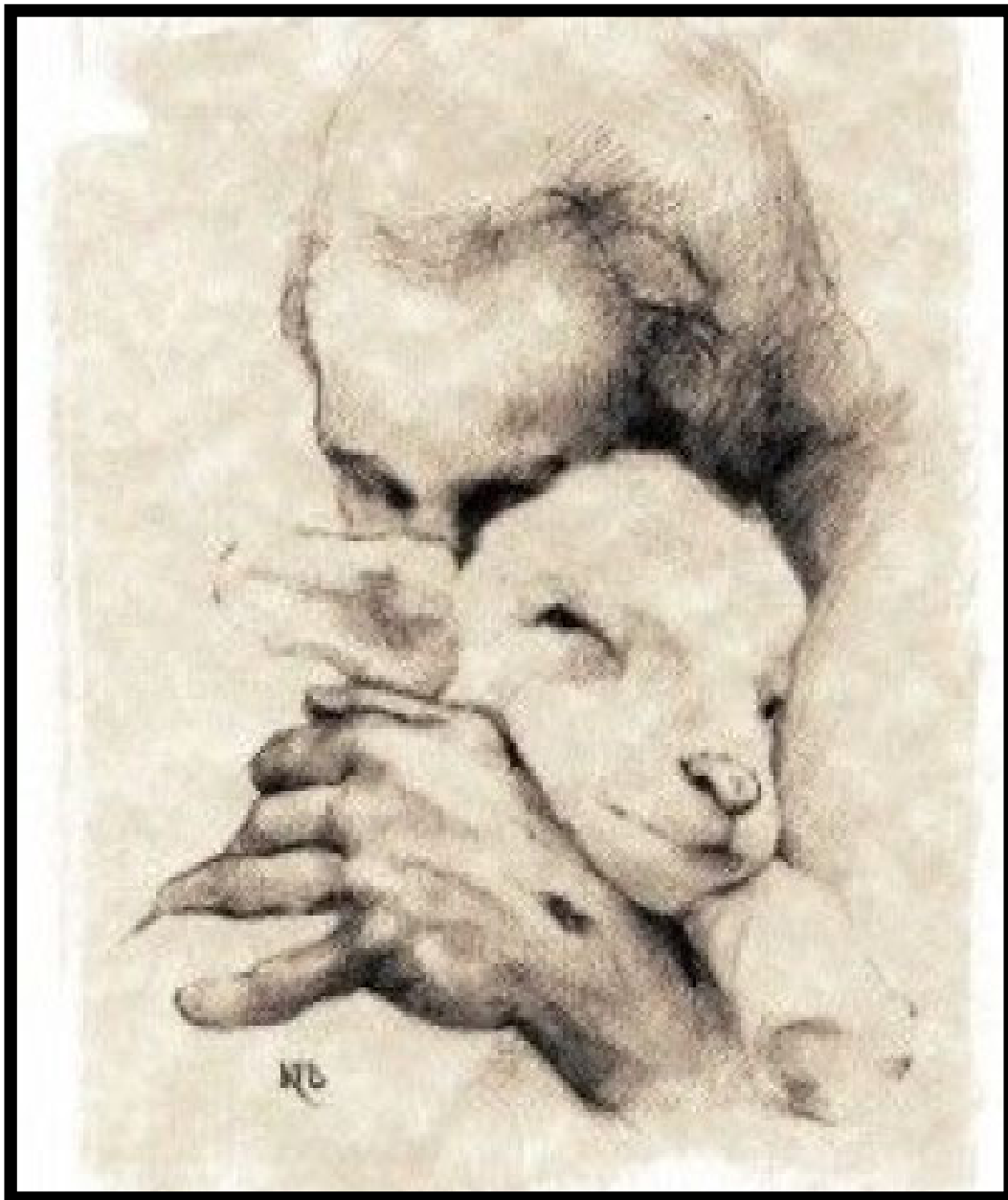

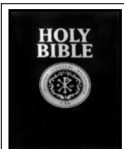

The Jewish historian, Josephus, writes that the early Disciples of Jesus were given the divine authority to "bind and to loose" based on established authority claimed by the Pharisees under Queen Alexandra. This early rabbinical power and authority was vested in the Sanhedrin and received its final sanction from the celestial court of justice. When appointing his disciples, Jesus used this same familiar formula. **Dr. John Bergsma, Professor of Theology at Franciscan University of Steubenville**, narrates this 5-week DVD program which will take a close look at St. Peter and the development of the Petrine Primacy.

 Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the parish office six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

**Baptisms**  
 Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for the first Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents. A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.
