### Funerals

choral favorites of Handel, Mozart, Joncas, Clausen and others featured on the choir's recent European tour.

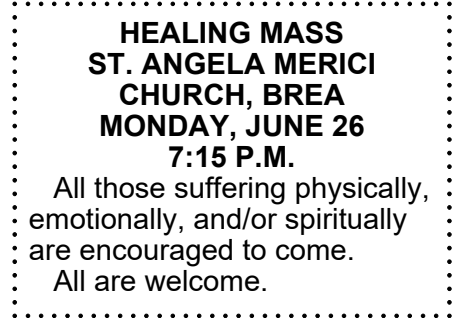
