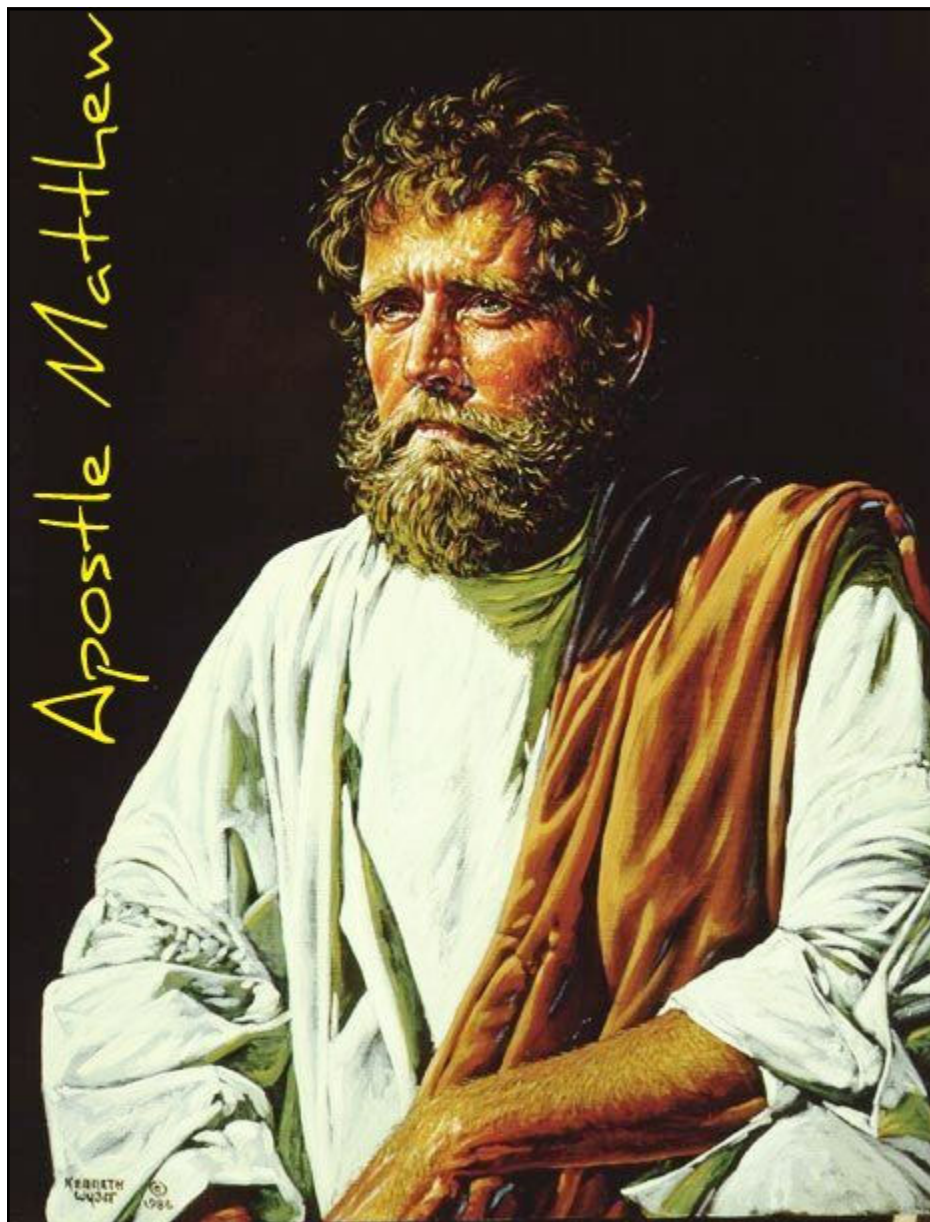

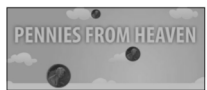

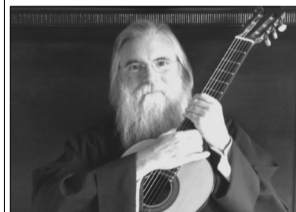
This annual Diocesan-wide fundraiser has been successful in providing necessary funding to our pregnancy homes and clinics in the Diocese of Orange.

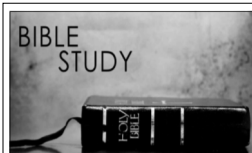

Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for the first Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents. A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.
