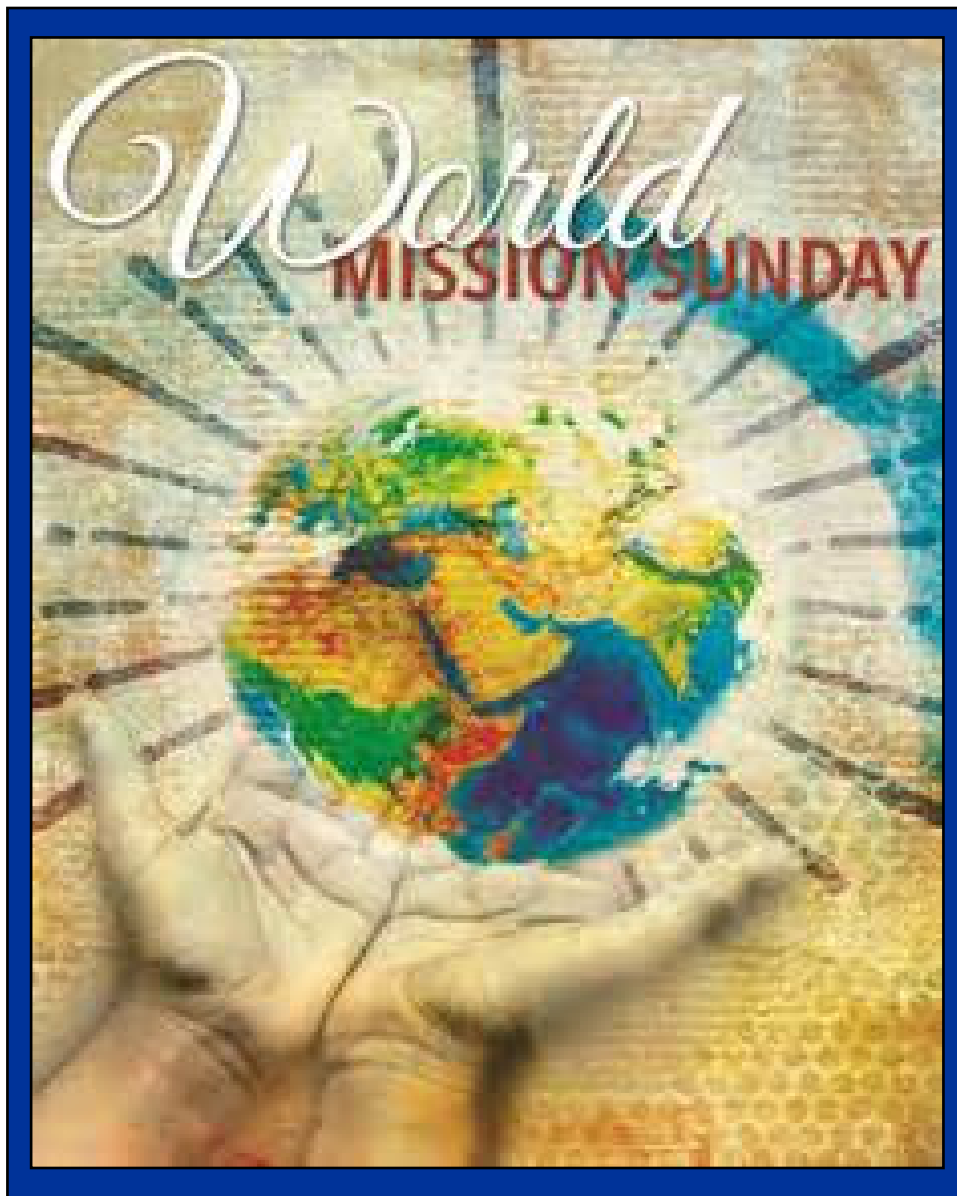

Family and friends of those in our parish family who have died this year have been invited to a Remembrance Mass which will begin at **10:00 a.m.**

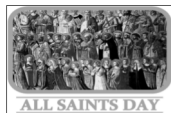
