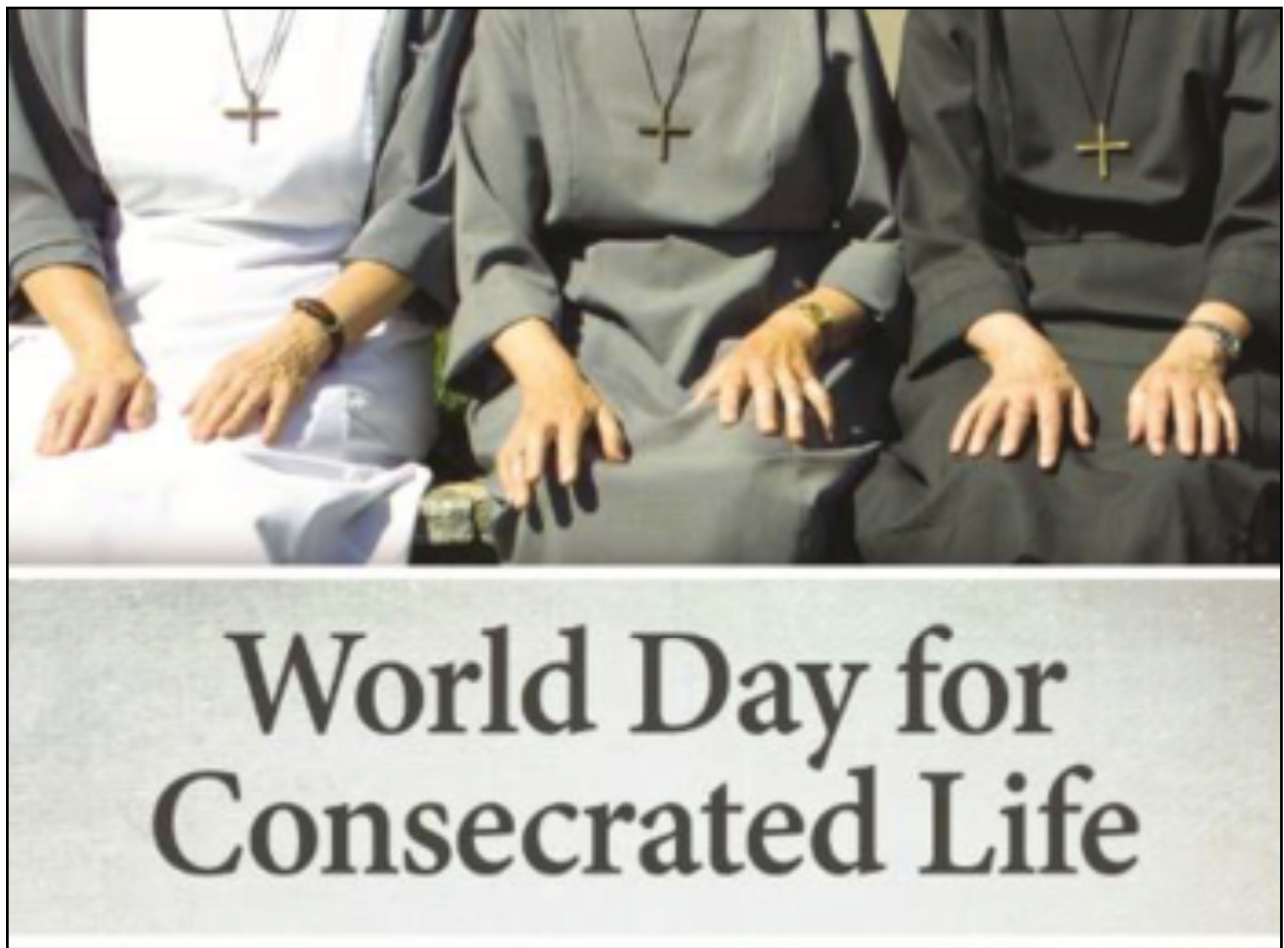

Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the parish office six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

**Baptisms**

Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for the second Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents.

A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.
