The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be offered following the talk.

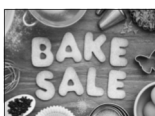

Please keep him in your prayers as he transitions into this new role of service to the Bishop and the Diocese.



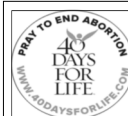
