It marks the accomplishment of the redemption of mankind. Truly, it is "the day that the Lord has made."

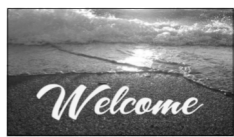
It is the feast of the glorious triumph of our holy faith.
