 it quickly spread far and wide into Gentile regions.

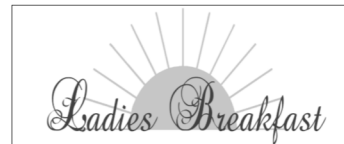

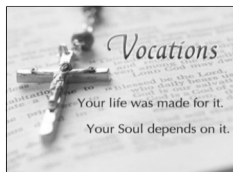
