

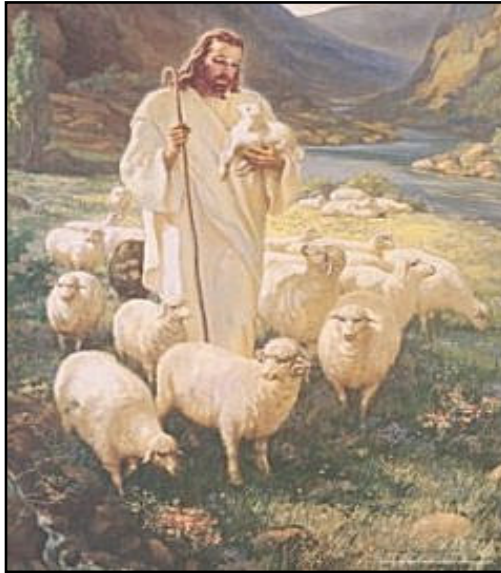

Sacrament of Matrimony

Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the parish office six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

Baptisms

Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for the second Sunday of every month. Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents. A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.

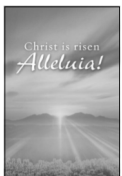

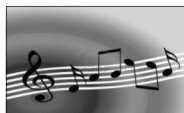
Balboa Bridge will be closed from 5:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. and will be re-opened in time for Mass at 8:00 a.m.

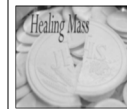

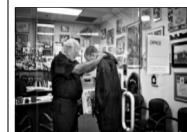
