Registration and preparation are required. Please contact the parish office six months in advance of desired wedding date. At least one member of the engaged couple must be a practicing Catholic and a member of the Chapel at least one year prior to the wedding date.

Baptisms

Baptisms are *usually* scheduled for the second Sunday of every month.

Sacramental preparation is requested for parents and Godparents. A Godparent must be a practicing and confirmed Catholic and, if married, married in the Church.

HOUSE OF PRAYER FOR PRIESTS DIOCESE OF ORANGE

The House of Prayer for Priests here in our Diocese of Orange is located across the street from Holy Sepulcher Cemetery in East Orange and provides a quiet place for prayer and reflection with overnight accommodations for up to nine priests.

FATHER DOMENICO is the *Director of the House of Prayer* and is available to Priests for spiritual direction and for Mass and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Through the wonderful generosity of Orange County Catholics, the House of Prayer was designed and built over 35 years ago and now has begun to show need for major repair. A new roof and significant repairs to the rooms and grounds are needed. The Priests in each deanery (a cluster of 8 to 10 parishes) have been asked to **raise \$20,000.00 in each of the 7 deaneries** of the Diocese of Orange to cover the expense of the repairs.
