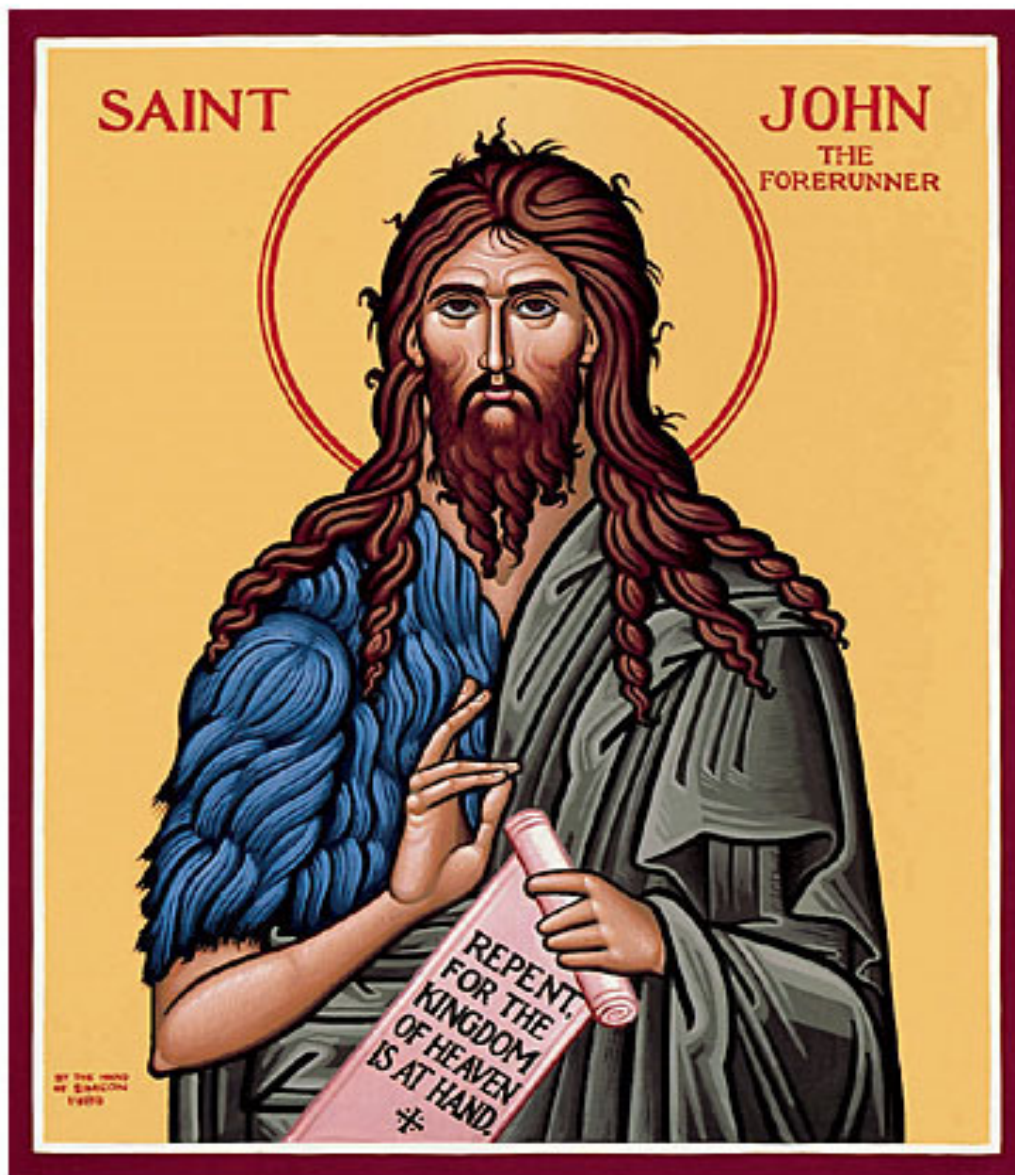

**myParish APP**

Diocese of Orange parishes are encouraged to use **myParish**, a free app providing parishioners with prayers, readings and homilies, as well as bulletins, Mass and confession times, social media links and updates from Bishop Vann. The app is an important communication tool for parishioners, clergy and lay staff. **myParish** is available for free download on iOS and Android mobile devices. A new feature for version 4.0 of the app allows users across our Diocese to stay connected to their parish via direct messaging.
